



HDR (HIGH DYNAMIC RANGE) TRAINING COURSE

It is a training course addressed to expert photographers.

The objective of this HDR training course consists in the experimentation and application of the High Dynamic Range Photography, study and debate on the refining and personalization of the technique, highlighting its qualities and limits.

The training aims to create images by employing the HDR technique in various photographic fields such as photography of landscapes, architecture, nocturnal, blue hours, portray, still-life and artistic.

The final objectives of the course consist in the realization of the webinar conducted by Acquamarina in September 2015, the exhibition and the catalogue to be arranged and produced on the occasion of the international meeting planned for the month of February 2016 in Trieste and of the final meeting of the Erasmus+ European Project "European blended learning and HDR Photography" to be held in Portugal in May 2016.
